News from Honduras

Please pray for Honduras. Like many other countries, it has had a prolonged period of rain. The rivers are full, bridges washed away & flooding near the rivers. These areas are usually inhabited by the poorest people. The land is saturated, making the mountain surfaces unstable, leading to land & mud slides, which result in death & loss of homes. The rainy season has not yet finished & the risk remains that more heavy rain could be disastrous.

Pasta

The price of pasta is expected to go up substantially in the near future. A 500g packet of value, own brand pasta shapes has already gone up to 49p. If you are thinking of buying any to send next year this would be a good time to buy. The dates are into 2012 and it is a very stable product which stores well.

Kelloggs

We have just become aware of a promotion run by Kelloggs. With three special codes from promotional packs, they are giving away a 500g box of cereal and 2 pints of skimmed milk. If

we can collect them, it would provide more cereal to send and I would sell the milk to provide more cereal. We send cereal to two locations where it is fed through the schools and colleges when they are unable to cook food. The reason we do not send more is the expense of cereal. This offer could allow us to send more free. The special code is on the grey side of the front of the packet. You can post or e-mail the codes to me. We have to get the code exactly right to make the offer work. The offer ends 30th September.
